

Milvon to West River 115-kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project Virtual Open House Welcome Video Script

Welcome to our online Interactive Open House. You can learn about UI's Milvon to West River 115-kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project on this Open House site. This video is an overview of how to navigate the site by clicking on banners where you will find information about the electric transmission line rebuild, register your attendance, and submit your comments and/or questions.

So, let's get started.

Under the video screen is a small display on the desk that says **REGISTRATION AND COMMENTS**. Here is where you should register your visit to this site and submit comments and/or questions. The UI Outreach toll-free number and email address are located here if you want to contact us directly. Your input on the Milvon to West River 115-kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project is very important to us.

Next to the video screen you will see **the FIND YOUR HOME banner**. To see whether your home or business is located near the transmission route, click on the **FIND YOUR HOME banner**. Type your address into the "Address" field and you will see your location in relation to where the rebuild is proposed.

Next on the left is the **PROJECT OVERVIEW AND ENGINEERING** banner. Here you can learn about why the Project is necessary to maintain and enhance the reliability of the transmission grid, and you can see the Project Overview map, Project Fact Sheet, Right-of-Way Cross Sections and other engineering exhibits, and links to portions of the main Project website to view information about the Construction Process and additional Project information.

Next on your left is the **ENVIRONMENTAL & Community** Banner. Here you can view the anticipated permits and approvals required to build the Project, view environmental exhibits, and view information related to the Connecticut Siting Council Application.

The next banner is the **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS** banner. Click on it to see the answers to many of the questions you may have.

The last banner on the far left is the **CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL PROCESS banner.** "Siting of Major Utility Transmission
Facilities," requires a full environmental, public health and safety impact
review of the siting, design, construction, and operation of major
transmission facilities in Connecticut. Here you can see the information
related to the Connecticut Siting Council process and learn how you can get
involved if you so choose.

Now that you have a sense of how to interact with this virtual open house web site, and where to find information about the Project; we encourage you to explore the site.
